STAR Circle holds me in support, solidarity and accountability for HeArt Centred Liberation, a cultural changemaking practice which is informed by my social, ecological and ritual arts practice. STAR Circle is a small trusted group of creative and pioneering individuals with whom I have a connection, and am in an ongoing relationship of soul solidarity. We are all involved in the realms of social, racial, and ecological justice working within the arts, research, law, reparative restitution, education, repair, healing and contemplative practice. Our commitment is to contributing to communities and a planet free from oppression and degradation to humans, the more-than-human and the Living Earth. All members of STAR Circle have experience or knowledge of HeART Centred Liberation as an experiential and liberatory practice with art and ritual.

HeArt Centred Liberation is a heart ecology of artful, ecological and ritual processes for racial justice and collective liberation. Within this body of work I host HeArt of Change, Loosening the Warp, and White Shadow Circles dedicated to dismantling white body supremacy. This is single identity work specifically for small groups of people racialised as white who are committed to dismantling systemic racism by addressing internalised patterns of white privilege. Within heartful and non-judgemental conditions we share, acknowledge, work on, and release the inherited supremacist feelings and behaviours which we carry in our body, mind and psyches. In recognition of our social and ecological interdependence, we gather for collective inquiry and relational healing, working with art and ritual processes for human liberation and ecosystem restoration. HeArt of Change engages in justice practices which contribute to racial justice movements for equity and collective liberation -cultural diversity and biodiversity are entwined.
